Entries are due no later than 5 PM, March 1, 2024. Following judging, notification to finalists will take place on or before March 12th. All winners will be announced during Community Day celebrations, March 15, 2024, at the Fairgrounds

Winner Categories:

Each Contest will have winners in the following grade levels.

- 4th 5th: 1st Prize, 2nd Prize & 3rd Prize
- 6th 8th : 1st Prize, 2nd Prize & 3rd Prize 9th 12th: 1st Prize, 2nd Prize & 3rd Prize

Contest Guidelines:

ART CONTEST:

Creatively illustrate what "How will your generation contribute to the next 60 years in our community?" means to you.

• The minimum size for all entries is (8 1/2x11). Maximum size and medium (traditional or digital) are left to the artist's discretion, however we suggest the proportions should not exceed (26x26x4), and weigh less than 15 lbs. Dimensional works such as ceramics, wood, clay, and others must be contained and secure (no loose pieces) and fall within a similar size and weight range. Photography will not be accepted. Pieces must be labeled with name and contact information. Artworks not meeting these guidelines will disqualify entry.

• An conventional Art Rubric will be used to judge art entries

ESSAY CONTEST:

Creatively express "How will your generation contribute to the next 60 years in our community?" Essays are required to be no less than:

- 200 words for 4th-5th grades
- 300 words for 6th-8th grades
- 400 words for 9th-12th grades
- Essays must be your own original work
- Essays must relate to the theme
- All essays must be double spaced, typed, using 12 point, Times New Roman (font)
- SIX-TRAITS rubric will be used to judge essay entries

All entries must be submitted to the Tribal Education Department By 5:00 PM on Friday, March 1, 2024
