2024 CHIEF AZUL SCHOLAR AWARD

Chief Antonio Azul "Mavith Kavdom" (Lion Shield), born 1817, is recognized as the last Head Chief of the Akimel O'otham. In a letter to the Arizona Territorial Governor in 1866, Chief Azul wrote, "The Pimas and Maricopas want nothing from the government except schools". His statement shows how the O'otham and Pee Posh people of Gila River understood the importance of education for future generations. Chief Antonio Azul passed away on October 1, 1909.

The Tribal Education Department announces the 2024 Chief Azul Scholar Award which recognizes educational achievements, academic excellence and leadership. This award recognizes individual student scholars and provides motivation for Gila River Students to aspire to reach higher academic goals.

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ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS FOR AWARD

- Enrolled Members and Direct Descendants of the Gila River Indian Community (GRIC)
 - O Direct Descendant: Mother or Father Enrolled with GRIC Certificate of Indian Blood Required
- Enrolled Student in 4th-12th grade or
- Full-time Undergraduate College Student
- Meets or exceeds the Selection Criteria

NOMINATIONS AND APPLICATION DOCUMENTS

Students in grades 4th to 12th:

All nominations must be submitted on the Chief Azul Scholar Nomination Form. The Nomination form must be completed fully and must be signed off by a school official. A school staff member or administrator, K-12 Advisor or Parent must complete the nomination form and submit on behalf of the student. All supporting application documents indicated on the checklist must be included with the Nomination Form.

Undergraduate Students:

All nominations must be submitted on the Chief Azul Scholar Nomination Form. The Nomination form must be completed fully and must be signed off by a school official. A Professor, Student Advisor, or Parent must complete the nomination form and submit on behalf of the student. All supporting application documents indicated on checklist must included with the Nomination Form.

SELECTION CRITERIA

- Excellent attendance record (Minimum 85%) with no behavior referrals.
- Consistent performance and demonstrates high academic engagement with a strong academic record.
- Demonstrates desire and ability to overcome barriers and achieve their goals.
- Individual determination to succeed; self-motivated in completing challenging coursework.
- Demonstrates knowledge of and/or interest in the GRIC culture.
- Documented record of participation in extracurricular activities, volunteer/community service.

☐ Enrollment Verification (Must be current full-time student). ☐ Current Resume or Vitae that outlines student interests, volunteerism, community service, and achievements.
☐ One letter of recommendation from a current or former Professor/Instructor.
□ Personal Essay: " <i>How does school help shape your future and what drives you to succeed?</i> " typed, double-spaced, 12 point font, 1,000 word maximum.

JUDGING PROCESS

- Nominations will be reviewed by a panel of selected GRIC Community Members or Employees.
- The panel will rank the Nominations according to how well they meet or exceed the criteria and select the 3 highest scoring students per grade level.
- There will be one Chief Azul Scholar and two Honorable Mentions per grade level.
