What to Bring:

To help us best support your child, please bring the following items to your Child Find appointment:

Your Child – The screening includes direct interaction, so your child must be present.

Birth Certificate – To verify your child's age.

Proof of Residency – A utility bill, lease, or other document showing your current address.

Photo ID – For parent or legal guardian identification.

Immunization Records – A current copy of your child's vaccinations.

Medical or Developmental Records (if applicable) – Include reports from doctors, early intervention services, or therapists.

IEP or IFSP (if applicable) – If your child already has an Individualized Education Plan (IEP) or Individualized Family Service Plan (IFSP).

Any Concerns or Questions – Make a list of any observations or concerns you have about your child's development.

What to Expect:

Your Child Find appointment is designed to help identify any developmental or learning needs your child may have before entering school. Here's what you can expect during your visit:

Warm Welcome & Sign-In You'll check in at the front desk and confirm your documents. Staff will be available to assist you.

Developmental Screening Our trained team will work with your child in a quiet, friendly setting to observe and assess:

Communication skills (talking and understanding)

Motor skills (movement and coordination)

Cognitive skills (thinking and problem-solving)

Social-emotional development (interacting and coping)

Vision and hearing (basic checks may be included)

Parent Interview You'll have a chance to share your observations, ask questions, and discuss any concerns with a specialist.

Review of Results After the screening, we'll review initial findings with you. If additional evaluations are recommended, we'll explain next steps.
