ARIZONA DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION – CERTIFICATION UNIT

The certificate is optional and issued to individuals to teach a Native American language in grades PreK-12.

The certificate is valid for twelve (12) years and may be renewed.

All requirements for the Certificate must be met:

- 1. Completed *Application for Certification*.
- 2. Appropriate fee (See *Application for Certification*)
- 3. A photocopy of your valid Arizona Department of Public Safety Identity Verified Prints (<u>IVP</u>) fingerprint card. For more information visit http://www.azed.gov/educator-certification/fingerprint-clearance-card-ivp/.
- 4. Language proficiency in a Native American Language. Proficiency shall be verified on official letterhead by a person(s) or entity designated by the appropriate tribe.
